For over 178 years, Procter & Gamble (P&G) has been home to a range of well-known brands, offering products from healthcare to home care and beyond. The company serves consumers in more than 180 countries.

A longtime leader in consumer products, P&G has evolved as it has pursued goals of growth, sustainability, and continuous improvement. For example, report and query execution times varied greatly, data latency was high, and poor application availability and other critical defects were cropping up. 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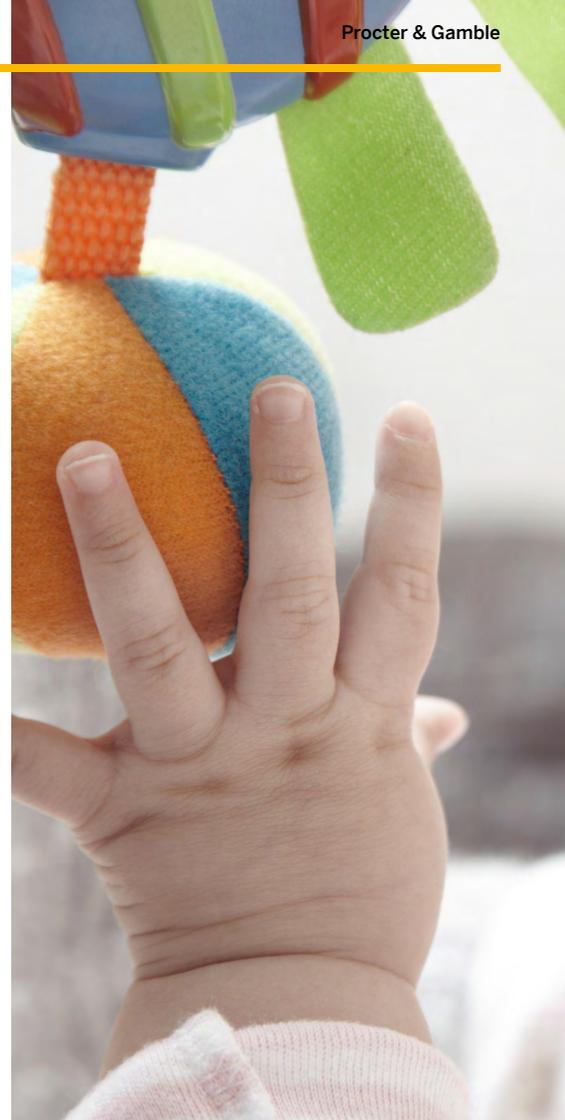
